### **ARTISTIC PROFIL**

Since my adolescence, I have been driven by an intimate and profound quest: to discover the invisible intrinsic link that connects all things. This search is the result of a dual experience, rooted in two seemingly opposite worlds: art and science. It is this constant back-and-forth between instinct and reason that defines my artistic approach, offering a unique and meaningful perspective.

Creative process: Art —and painting in particular— acts as a catalyst. It is at once psychoanalysis, meditation, conceptual tool, and a field of sensitive experimentation. A way of exploring the world within oneself as much as the world around us. It allows opposites to enter into dialogue: rigor and spontaneity, abstraction and matter, chaos and form.

To bring this forth, I navigate between radical letting go —the condition for the unexpected to emerge— and more cerebral moments where intellect and aesthetics take over. Our reality is both tangible and intangible, rational and mystical, neither one nor the other, yet all at once. It is this paradoxical coexistence that I seek to bring to light in my works.

Technique: Self-taught, I have built a practice freed from traditional codes in order to transcend their constraints and open up a more organic space of creation. I design my own tools according to the needs of the moment: felt combs, mutant brushes, wooden scrapers or razor blades. I work barefoot on large canvases placed on the floor, which I tread with varying delicacy. Painting literally escapes the frame to become a territory of total freedom.

In this workspace, instinct and reason intertwine and respond to each other. The body acts in spontaneity, the mind in reflection. Curved, organic lines intertwine with pure forms, and abstraction becomes the field of this embrace. I use a time-lapse capture process that reveals this duality, where time is treated as a graphic element, as the transcription of another dimension retracing the artistic journey.



### **Performances**

From very early on, I felt the need to go beyond the canvas — to make it vibrate, resonate, dance. Painting, for me, is not a fixed object but a space of dialogue, a living vortex where forms, sounds, bodies, and spirit converge.

These immersive performances, created in collaboration with contemporary musicians and dancers, follow a jazz logic: improvisation, risktaking, pure presence.

Each discipline influences the other: gestures become notes, sounds become forms, rhythms sketch directions — a spontaneous score. Through an overhead video projection, the viewer is immersed in the process: they do not witness a fixed work, but its living genesis, as if at the heart of a ritual workshop.

These performances are not demonstrations but explorations. They seek to bring forth what escapes words: a sensitive language that crosses genres, bodies, and cultures. The resulting work is a trace — the record of a fleeting yet charged dialogue, like a jazz solo, ephemeral and necessary, suspended in a moment of absolute attention.

### Conclusion

What runs through my work, almost obsessively, is the desire for connection. Connection between ideas, disciplines, scales of perception, layers of the sensorial. It addresses universal, even existential questions that transcend genres and cultures and probe our human condition.

As an artist, I explore these themes to offer a global vision of the world and invite viewers to reflect on what unites us. I invite each observer to dive into my works as one enters a meditative or dreamlike space — a place where the visible becomes a pretext to explore what connects us, inside and out.

### **ADN**

Biography

Son of two visual artists but first a veterinarian, osteopath, and acupuncturist, I explored life through science before dedicating myself to painting. This path, seemingly indirect, actually follows a clear line: the pursuit of deep knowledge, of transcendence.

From allopathic medicine to holistic medicine, I gradually moved toward an ever more sensitive approach, until the revelation of painting: the absolute power of the creative gesture, capable of encompassing and transforming everything.

It took me ten years to acknowledge this vital need and to earn legitimacy in a universe for which I had not been trained —without an academic background in Fine Arts, but with creation already within me, a latent heritage from my artist mothers.

An inveterate nomad, I have lived on three continents —Europe, Asia, South America—, a life of travels and new beginnings that shaped my vision. Now based in Rio de Janeiro, I aim to take a new step: to develop ambitious projects and find a strategic partner to anchor my work over time.









## **Performances**


